**Memo:**

Lately, it has been observed that a number of students are applying for migration from one school to another. This phenomenon is more prominent in certain major well reputed schools. Despite the fact that most of these private institutions know that the last date for submission of migration certificate is December 31, 2013.

This office has been informed that private institutions following their detention examination or due to poor performance of some students stop them from appearing from their schools in annual examination. These schools are unwilling to send their admission forms for examination and somehow inform their parents to find out alternate schools for their children. The main fear behind all this is that the school concern may not get bad results in SSC annual examination. Hence, academic performance of institution is preferred over the career of the student and forcing parents to knock at the door of BISE Peshawar at eleventh hour.

It is therefore suggested that students of average performance may not be forced to leave the school. And if they have any problem their parents must be informed well in time. Lastly, the school concern may inform the parents to apply for migration before December 31, the date fixed for migration.
